Harvest Area. Decadent and Deformed Trees of Value to Wildlife (excluding hardwoods) shall not count towards required stocking standards.

(D) All harvested conifers shall be within three hundred (300) feet of a

California black oak or Oregon white oak that is a minimum of four (4) inches dbh.

(E) All Slash created by the Timber Operations shall be treated to achieve a maximum postharvest depth of eighteen (18) inches above the ground within twenty four (24) months of the date that the director received the submitted notice. Treated Slash shall be configured in a manner that minimizes risk of fire related mortality to all retained California black oak or Oregon white oak.

(5) Timber Operations shall comply with the limits established in 14 CCR § 1038, subsection (b)(1) –(10).

(6)An exemption pursuant to 14 CCR § 1038(I) is not applicable to timberlands within the Southern Sub-District of the Coast District as defined in 14 CCR § 895.1. or the Southern District as defined in 14 CCR § 909.

(7) The exemption shall include the tentative commencement date of Timber

Operations on the notice required in 14 CCR § 1038.2. Within a fifteen (15) day
