12 (f) A RPF retained by the plan submitter to provide professional advice throughout
13 timber operations, or their designee, shall, prior to the commencement of operations or
14 upon taking responsibility of a Plan, perform an on-site inspection of the Logging Area
15 scheduled for operation for that given year and to ensure that work required of a RPF
16 under Board rules and regulations is accurate and in conformance with the approved
17 Plan.

23 **§ 1035.3. Licensed Timber Operator Responsibility.**

1 (d) Comply with all provisions of the Act, Board rules and regulations; for timber
2 operations, the applicable approved plan and any approved amendments to the Plan. A
3 LTO shall not be held responsible for violations that result from inaccurate or
4 inadequate work that requires a RPF under Board rules and regulations.
