ASPEN RESTORATION REGULATIONS REVIEW**Date of Field Trip: October 28, 2010**

The State Board of Forestry and Field Protection will be holding a field trip to review aspen restoration projects as part of a review of the California Forest Practice Rules section 14 CCR § 939.15 [959.15] Protection of Wildlife - Aspen and Meadow Restoration.

The field trip will be held in Lassen County, CA on Fruit Growers Supply Company lands and Lassen National Forest. The area is west and south of Bogard Rest Area on Highway 44. Bogard is located 30 miles northwest of Susanville and 20 miles south of Old Station, CA. See attached map of locations.

9:00 am: Meet at Bogard Rest Area in the overflow parking lot (2nd right after turning off Highway 44)

9:15 – 12:00 pm: Head out to Stop #1 and #2

Stop #2, Silver Lake THP 2-04-195-LAS (Harvested)

12:00 – 1:00 pm: Bogard Campground (Bring your own lunch)

1:00 – 4:00 pm: Stop #3 and #4

Stop #3, Bridge Creek THP 2-06-145 LAS (In the process of being harvested)

Stop #4, Sheep Camp THP 2-08-047-LAS (Approved but not harvested)


4:00 pm: Wrap-up and adjourn
